Use it as a **personal devotion** on Sunday morning.

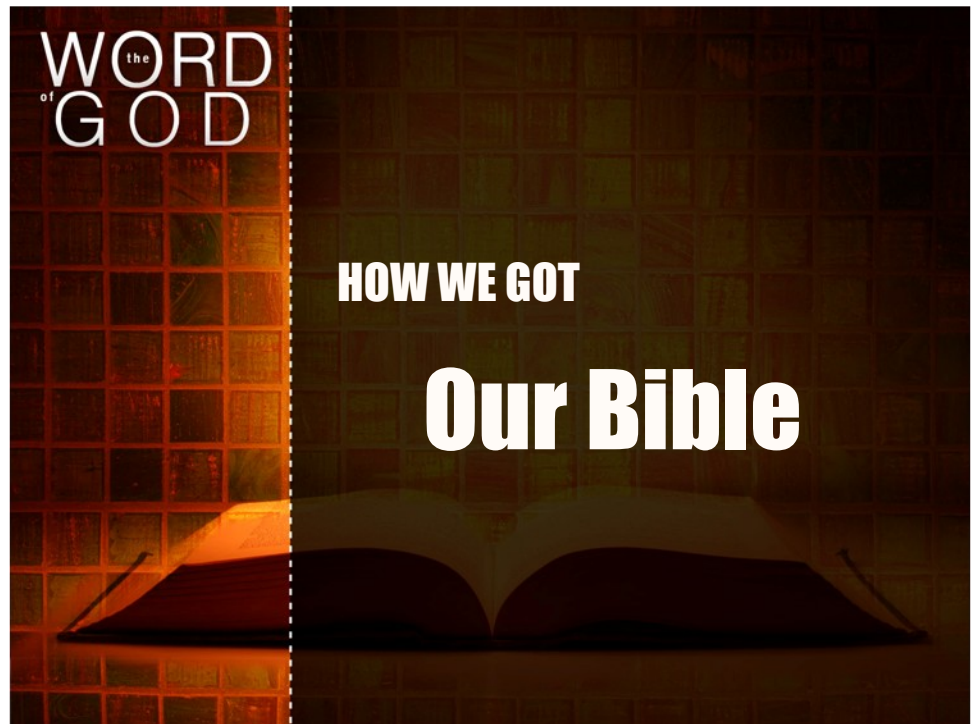
Give it to a guest you are inviting to come to the services
